Choose the right program for your situation.

1. If the candidate is a graduate/post graduate from a reputed university in India and with any international certification in any of the following fields: Information technology, Hospitality, Business, Health science, Accounting: then choose to do a one year program (two semesters) followed by an additional semester in General Arts and Science and be automatically eligible for a three-year work permit.
2. If the candidate doesn't have good employable skill sets but possesses a graduate degree or postgraduate degree, choose to do a full two-year program (four semesters) in any of the following areas: Hospitality and Tourism, Culinary and Wine, Business, International Business Administration, Sales and Marketing, Human Resource Management, Wine Business, Business Accounting, Information technology, Computer programmer, Public relations, Advanced lasers, Construction engineering, Electronics engineering, Mechanical engineering, Automotive technology, Ecosystem restoration.
3. If the candidate is a business oriented person who likes to learn international business and begin business right away, then choose to do a one or two year International Business Administration program with an option to transfer credits to a US university to complete an MBA.
4. Candidates who have completed 10+2 post secondary studies can pursue a four year undergraduate degree program. Enroll in one of the following programs: Bachelor of Applied Business—Hospitality Management. Or (2) Bachelor of Applied Business—International Commerce and Global Development.
5. For IT professionals and engineering graduates can enroll in any of the following two year program in any of the following programs: Computer engineering/Computer programming/System analyst/Web design/Advanced lasers/Electrical engineering/Electronics engineering/Mechanical engineering/Photonics engineering.

On -Campus and Off-Campus work:

You will be able to work 12 hours per week on-campus while you are studying. After completing six months of study, you will be entitled to apply for an off campus work visa which allows you to work 20 hours during school and full time during vacations. Minimum wage in Canada is \$10.25 per hour.

Minimum English score requirements: IELTS : 6.0 (no band under 5)

When to apply: You should apply three to eight months before the start of the term. General intakes are in September (Fall Semester) and January (Spring Semester). Please note: Seats get filled pretty quickly in this college.

Significant observations seen from earlier and current students from India at the college:
